



Verb tenses: Past Continuous

= A continuous action which
finished in the past

*"I was
living"*

"To live" (regular)

– Positive form

– Question form

I, He, she, it	! was living	Was I ? living?	
You, we, they	were living	You, we, they	were living

– Negative form

I, He, she, it	X was not living	("I wasn't living")	Inf.
You, we, they	were not living	("You weren't living")	

Example sentences

- I saw her while I **was having** lunch.
- He phoned as I **was walking** to work.
- It arrived while we **were talking**.
