



Verb tenses:

Present Continuous

For something happening:

- Generally now
- Precisely now

"I am living"

Time expressions

- At the moment
- Right now
- Currently

"To live" (regular)

– Positive form

– Question form

I	! am living	Inf. ("I'm living")	Am	? I living?
You, we, they	are living	Inf. ("You're living")	Are	you, we, they living?
He, she, it	is living	Inf. ("He's living")	Is	he, she, it living?

– Negative form

I	X am not living	Inf. ("I'm not living")	Inf.
You, we, they	are not living	Inf. ("You're not living")	OR: "You are nt..."
He, she, it	is not living	Inf. ("He's not living")	OR: "He is'nt..."

Example sentences

i. Precisely now:

- I'm walking back to the hotel
- I'm waiting for the bus
- I'm cooking dinner at the moment



ii. Now generally:

- I'm reading a good book at the moment
- She's saving for a new car right now
