Verb tenses: Present Simple

For: i. Talking generally
ii. Talking about habit

"I live"

Time expressions

***** Always
***** Every day / week / year.
***** Usually
***** Often
*** Sometimes
** Rarely
* Never

"To live" (regular)

– Positive form

I, you, we, they	!	live
He, she, it		lives

– Question form

Do I, you, we, they	?	live?
Does he, she, it		live?

– Negative form

I, you, we, they	X	do not live	Inf. ("I don't live")
He, she, it		do not live	Inf. ("He doesn't live")

"To be" (irregular)

– Positive form

I	!	am	Inf. ("I'm")
You, we, they		are	Inf. ("You're")
He, she, it		is	Inf. ("He's", etc.)

– Question form

Am	?	I?
Are		you, we, they?
Is		he, she, it

– Negative form

I	X	am not	Inf. ("I'm not")
You, we, they		are not	Inf. ("You're not")
He, she, it		is not	Inf. ("He's not", etc.)

Example sentences

i. Talking generally:

- I live in Chicago
- Water boils at 100°C



ii. Habit:

- I play tennis every Saturday
- We often go on holiday to Spain
